After shooting your prescreen, we will submit your videos to 2 of these industry professionals for review. If prescreens aren't required for your college application, we will still submit a practice audition video to be reviewed. You will receive feedback on each aspect of your prescreen audition, including monologues, songs, and dances. The reviewers will share general to specific comments including positive reinforcement and constructive criticism. Videos must be submitted to these reviewers by September 30 or sooner to ensure a timely response.
